The candidate must possess excellent verbal, written, and communication skills as well as have an in-depth knowledge and application of parts acquisition and inventory management.

The Parts & Logistics Coordinator must also have an excellent understanding of shipping, receiving and cross border rules and regulations as applicable to both importing and exporting heavy equipment as well as related parts and accessories.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Parts and Inventory:

- a. Sourcing and acquiring parts in a timely manner for customers, service department and technicians
- Ongoing communication and follow up with customers and staff on ETA of parts requests
- c. Assist customers in parts requests. Prepare accurate quotations and follow up with customers to close the sales
- d. Manage multiple vendors and develop and ongoing understanding of price, quality, delivery time, etc. for all of our parts requirements



- e. Develop ongoing relationships with our suppliers to ensure quality service and timely supply of our parts when they are most needed
- f. Develop processes and procedures to ensure efficiency in all aspects of the job
- g. Ensure inventory system is set up with max(s) & min(s) as well as all seasonal adjustments
- h. Parts Neat, organized, well labelled as per a master inventory plan
- i. Compliance with, and application of, all Bigfoot Crane policies and procedures which may be implemented or upgraded from time to time
- j. Completion of all paperwork required to ensure accurate parts and inventory management
- k. Factory communication and follow up on parts warranty claims
- I. Perform inventory audits as required

Safety

- a. Retain a level 1 first aid certificate and be the First Aid Attendant for the office and yard
- b. Attend monthly safety meetings

Shipping / Receiving:

- a. Manage best practices regarding paper work, cost control, and cross border compliance
- b. Operate forklifts and yard crane as required for shipping and receiving duties

Building:

a. Assist with building inspections, maintenance and repair schedules

Warehouse and Shop:

- a. Shop organization for professionalism, maximum efficiency and safety (Incl. Tool crib, welding area, Boscaro storage, mezzanines, etc...)
- b. Inspection, repairs, maintenance and security reviews

- Sales skills with ability to produce parts quotations as well as follow up and close parts sales on an ongoing basis.

- A good understanding of the workings of our equipment including their mechanical and electrical functions
