After 8 days, you are fully prepared for your Full Scope Certification theory and practical exams to become a certified crane operator. Upon successful completion of the assessment, you become a certified Full Scope Self-Erecting Crane Operator with no restrictions.

Taught by an accomplished Red Seal crane operator and instructor, the Full Scope certification training program combines in-class content with practical experience. Students are provided access to cranes to gain hours of operation and learn how to operate folding boom cranes one-on-one with a certified operator. The goal of the Full Scope training program is to equip you for the Full Scope Assessment and to provide additional opportunities to train to be safe and confident crane operators in the workforce.

Q: Who provides the crane certification assessment?

Q: Do I need to be registered with the crane association prior to taking classes?

A: Yes and you can register on-line at www.bcacs.ca.

Q: What happens if I do not pass parts of the assessment?

A: Our Crane Academy has a high success rate but if you are unsuccessful on either the theory or practical components in your final assessment, a re-assessment will be scheduled. You will only be required to re-assess for the portion in which you were unsuccessful. There are time limits and fees associated with the reassessment process.

Q: How long is the lunch break?

A: We provide a 30 minute lunch break and two short breaks mid-morning and afternoon.

Q: Is there anything I need to read before taking the course?

A: We love the enthusiasm! But no, there is no prep required prior to taking the course. We prefer that our instructors deliver all the fundamental material so our students receive the most accurate information, in addition to the appropriate application of that information in the field.

Q: How do I pay?
